

2024 IZAAK WALTON LEAGUE OF AMERICA AWARD NOMINEES SOUGHT (AWARDED IN YEAR 2025)

This packet contains all the details and forms you and your chapter or division need for this year's IWLA Awards (offered during 2025). The awards program is updated annually to make the nomination process more user-friendly and encourage more nominations of deserving League chapters, divisions, and individual members. Changes and points to note include the following:

- The 2024 Defenders Chapter Achievement Award and the 2024 Judge John W. Tobin Chapter Volunteer Appreciation Award forms (the first two forms found in this packet) are included. However, the March 15, 2025 deadline for submitting these two award forms is earlier than for the National Awards.
- The **deadline** for submitting other **National Award** nominations remains later at **June 1, 2025**. This is to enable the Awards Committee to meet and still allow adequate time for award preparations. This means some IWLA divisions may be holding state meetings after the award nomination deadline please note that "division approval" does <u>not</u> mean the approval must be an outcome of a division meeting. A division may have their president or a separate awards chairman or some other method of their choosing (i.e., authorization by a national director) to allow the approval to be granted (and then perhaps later reported on as an "action taken" at the division meeting).
- As a reminder, should the nominee member, non-member, organization or chapter be selected to receive an award, the <u>nominator</u> will need to be prepared to supply photo(s) of the award recipient for potential future use during the awards presentation, in *Outdoor America* magazine, and on the League's website. Thank you in advance.
- A notable change: Completed applications may <u>no</u> longer be faxed to IWLA. However, they can be e-mailed to: <u>awards@iwla.org</u>. This e-mail address is noted on each nomination form, so if you would like to scan and e-mail your completed form(s) and attach supporting documents, you may do so. When e-mailing award application(s), please remember to request confirmation upon receipt.
- Each award has a **nomination form specific to the award** in this packet. The award criteria are outlined in more depth on each form to help identify potential nominees. Additionally, questions pertaining to the nominee and how they meet the specific award criteria are listed as a guideline to aid in filling out the nomination form.
- Both IWLA national directors and division officers are encouraged to actively be on the watch for worthy recipients and submit nominations.

THE DEFENDERS CHAPTER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Izaak Walton League's Defenders Chapter Achievement Award is named after the League's motto: "Defenders of Soil, Air, Woods, Waters and Wildlife." Based on your activities in the last calendar year, your chapter might be eligible to receive this national recognition for your many ongoing efforts and accomplishments.

To be eligible for this annual award designation, your chapter must have met criteria in five of the following categories during 2024: membership, financial contributions, education, conservation, youth involvement and communication.

Initial recognition of your chapter's 2024 accomplishments will be made at the 2025 IWLA National Convention, and will be published in a future issue of *Outdoor America*.

Applications for both awards were mailed in January to each chapter president, secretary and awards chair. 2024 NATIONAL AWARDS

AVAILABLE FOR DIVISION, CHAPTER, AND INDIVIDUAL RECOGNITION

The following is a summary of the National Awards are available for nomination from Izaak Walton League divisions and chapters. All are encouraged to submit nominations. Deadline for submitting the **2024 National Awards** nominations is **June 1, 2025** (postmarked).

- **54 Founders Award** This award (only 1), the League's highest honor, is given to an individual, group, or organization (member or non-member) judged to have made an outstanding contribution to the conservation of America's natural and renewable resources. Recipients should have a distinguished history of conservation achievement in a wide arena over the course of time.
- Hall of Fame Awards This award is designed to recognize members who have given long and devoted service to the League. Recipients of this award (up to 5) have achieved a record of outstanding accomplishment in furthering the mission and goals of the League over the course of time.
- **Honor Roll Awards** This award (up to 10) is designed to recognize non-members (groups or individuals) who have achieved outstanding accomplishments involving conservation, public education or publicity efforts in keeping with the League's goals.
- Conservation Awards This award (up to 12) recognizes individual member contributions to conservation in the League's name.
- Outdoor Ethics Awards This award (up to 6) recognizes individuals, groups, or organizations (member or non-member) judged to have done outstanding work in outdoor ethics during the past year.
- Save Our Streams Awards This award (up to 6) recognizes individuals, groups, or organizations (member or non-member) judged to have done outstanding work in demonstrating the principles of environmental education and citizen activism for clean water during the past year.
- Shooting Sports Awards This award (up to 6) recognizes individuals, groups, or organizations (member or non-member) judged to have done outstanding work to advance the shooting sports within or in support of the League during the past year.
- **Arthur R. Thompson Memorial Award** This award (only 1) recognizes the division that has carried out the most outstanding conservation program(s) during the past year.
- **James Lawton Childs Awards**† This award (up to 2) and monetary gift (\$250—courtesy IWLA Endowment) recognizes the chapter that has carried out the most outstanding conservation program(s) during the past year.
- Robert C. O'Hair Awards† This award (up to 2) and monetary gift (\$250) recognizes the chapter that has carried out the most outstanding youth program(s) during the past year.
- Thelma "Pete" Reed Memorial Award* This award (only 1) is presented to an individual member who has volunteered many hours at the local or state level in conservation projects, educational efforts, community service, or chapter leadership development. The member may not currently be a national leader of the League but, by virtue of his/her grassroots efforts, is considered an "up and coming" future leader of the Izaak Walton League.
- Outdoor America's Future Award* This award (only 1) is presented to an individual youth or student member who has volunteered many hours at the local or state level in conservation projects, related efforts in school, community service, or chapter leadership development. By virtue of his/her grassroots efforts, is considered an "up and coming" future leader of the League.
- **Best Division Newsletter Award** This award (only 1) is presented to the division judged to have the best newsletter in terms of appearance, originality, timeliness, and news coverage. The best newsletters focus not only on news from the division and its chapters, but also provide information about national and state news.
- **Best Chapter Newsletter Awards**† This award (up to 2) is presented to the chapter judged to have the best newsletter(s) in terms of appearance, originality, timeliness, and news coverage. The best newsletters focus not only on local chapter events but also provide information about national and state news, as well as community-related conservation topics.
- **Best Division** and **Chapter Website Awards** This award (1 each) honors the division <u>and</u> chapter judged to have created and/or maintained the most effective website(s) during the past year.
- Best Chapter Membership Recruitment and Retention Award* This award (only 1) and monetary gift (\$250) recognizes the chapter that carried out the most effective membership recruitment and retention programs in 2024.

NOTE: Submissions for most of the awards will not be considered by the Awards Committee without division endorsement.

- * Division approval is **not** required for this award.
